### AMENDMENTS OF THE CROWN LANDS REGULATIONS

1. Regulation 2 of the Crown Lands Regulations is amended by omitting— Parts  
"Division 2A—Occupation (Development) Licences (Regulations 87A-87K).".
2. Regulation 14 of the Crown Lands Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:  

"14.(1) The Chairman, or the Deputy Chairman, as the case may be, of the Board shall give reasonable notice of the time and place fixed for a meeting of the Board to an applicant or any other person who is entitled to appear or required to give evidence at that meeting. Chairman to notify of time and place of meeting of Board

"(2) In the case of an applicant for the right to a pastoral, agricultural or miscellaneous lease of land notified in the *Gazette* as being available for leasing, reasonable notice of the time and place fixed for the meeting of the Board to consider his application is not less than 28 days."
3. Division 2A of Part VII of the Crown Lands Regulations is repealed. Repeal of Occupational (Development) Licences regulations
4. The First Schedule to the Crown Lands Regulations is amended by omitting Forms 24 and 25. First Schedule
5. The Fourth Schedule to the Crown Lands Regulations is repealed. Repeal of Fourth Schedule
