## Regulation under the *Coal Ordinance* 1922-1969

I, FREDERICK CHARLES CHANEY, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, having received the advice of the Administrator's Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the *Coal Ordinance* 1922-1969 and the *Administrator's Council Ordinance* 1959-1963, hereby make the following Regulation.

### AMENDMENT OF THE COAL REGULATIONS†

Regulation 4 of the Coal Regulations is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulation:—

“(2.) A licence is subject to the condition that the licensee shall expend, in prospecting for coal on the subject land during the term of the licence or during specified years of that term, an amount of money that is or amounts of money that are not less than the amount or amounts of money determined by the Minister and specified in the licence as the amount or amounts to be expended during that term or those years, as the case may be.”.
