Regulations under the Dog Act

AMENDMENTS OF THE DOG REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on the expiration of 14 days from the date on which the making of the Regulations is notified in the *Gazette*.

2. PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

The Dog Regulations are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

3. FEES

Regulation 12(2) of the Principal Regulations is amended -

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) "pension; and" and substituting "pension; or"; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) "the dog" and substituting "a dog ".

Clause 3(b) of Schedule 3 to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting "Registrar" (second occurring) and substituting "register".

6. SCHEDULE 4

Clause 3 of Schedule 4 to the Principal Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

- "3. Section 57(c)(ii) for the release of a dog from a pound -
 - (a) where the dog was seized from within the Palmerston town area within the meaning of the Palmerston Town Development Act -
 - (i) for the first day or part of a day during which the dog was impounded 40.00
 - (ii) for each other day or part of a day during which the dog was impounded 5.00
 - (b) in all othe cases -
 - (i) for each Saturday, Sunday or public holiday during which or part of which the dog was impounded 7.50
 - (ii) for each other day or part of a day during which the dog was impounded
