# By-laws under the Local Government Act

The Darwin City Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the *Local Government Act* and in accordance with section 350(3) of the Act, at a meeting held on the 25th day of May, 1983, hereby makes the following By-laws.

# DARWIN (PRIVATE SWIMMING POOL) (AMENDMENT No. 1) BY-LAWS

#### CITATION

These By-laws may be cited as the Darwin (Private Swimming Pool) (Amendment No. 1) By-laws.

### 2. PRINCIPAL BY-LAWS

The Darwin (Private Swimming Pool) By-laws 1983 are, in these By-laws, referred to as the Principal By-laws.

### REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

By-law 2 of the Principal By-laws is repealed and the following substituted:

## "2. CROWN TO BE BOUND

"These By-laws bind the Crown in right of the Territory.".

## 4. TRANSITIONAL

(1) Where in the Principal By-laws as amended by these By-laws there is a reference to the commencement of the By-laws the reference shall, in relation to an obligation imposed on a person by the Principal By-laws as amended by these By-laws which did not exist before the commencement of these By-laws, be construed as a reference to the commencement of these By-laws.

(2) Where a person, before the commencement of these By-laws, purported to apply under section 5(1) or (3) of the Principal By-laws to the council for the registration of a private swimming pool or a proposed private swimming pool and he was not, before that commencement, obliged to so apply, the application shall be deemed to be an application made under the Principal By-laws as amended by these By-laws on the commencement of these By-laws and a certificate purporting to be issued under by-law 5(5) of the Principal By-laws before that commencement as the result of the application shall be deemed to have been duly issued on that commencement.
