AMENDMENTS OF THE ELECTRICITY (FEES AND CHARGES) REGULATIONS

Schedules 1 and 2 to the Electricity (Fees and Charges) Regulations are repealed and the following Schedules substituted:

Regulation 3

DOMESTIC SUPPLY

Consumption	Rate
Not more than 90 units of electricity	14.13 cents per unit of electricity
More than 90, but not more than 540 units of electricity	\$12.72 plus 5.35 cents for each unit of electricity in excess of 90 units
More than 540, but not more than 990 units of electricity	\$36.79 plus 3.9 cents for each unit of electricity in excess of 540 units
More than 990 units of electricity	\$54.34 plus 3.74 cents for each unit of electricity in excess of 990 units

"SCHEDULE 2

Regulation 4

COMMERCIAL SUPPLY

Consumption	Rate
Not more than 900 units of electricity	13.39 cents per unit of electricity
More than 900, but not more than 4,500 units of electricity	\$120.51 plus 9.18 cents for each unit of electricity in excess of 900 units
More than 4,500 but not more than 30,000 units of electricity	\$450.99 plus 7.99 cents for each unit of electricity in excess of 4,500 units
More than 30,000 but not more than 90,000 units of electricity	\$2,488.44 plus 5.62 cents for each unit of electricity in excess of 30,000 units
More than 90,000 units	\$5,860.44 plus 4.05 cents for each unit of electricity in excess of 90,000 units."
