

Regulation under the *Encouragement of Primary
Production Ordinance 1931-1968*

AMENDMENT OF THE ENCOURAGEMENT OF PRIMARY
PRODUCTION REGULATIONS †

Regulation 11 of the Encouragement of Primary Production Regulations is repealed and the following regulation is inserted in its stead:—

“11.—(1.) Where the Board has approved an advance, the Chairman or an officer of the Board thereto authorised by the Board may certify the correctness of an expenditure of funds for the purposes of that advance. Authorisation
of expenditure

(2.) A certification in accordance with the last preceding sub-regulation is a sufficient authority for the expenditure of the funds.

(3.) For the purposes of sub-regulation (1.) of this regulation, the Board may authorise an officer to certify the correctness of the expenditure of funds either in relation to advances generally or in relation to a particular advance.”
