#### "PART VIIA-PURCHASE AND POSSESSION

Purchase and possession of explosives "130A.(1) In this regulation, "prescribed area" means the area that is distant not more than 40 kilometres from the building known as the Darwin Post Office, but does not include any area that is below the low water mark of the sea.

"(2) Subject to the Ordinance and these Regulations, a person other than a person who holds a licence, shall not purchase in the prescribed area or possess in the prescribed area an explosive other than small arms ammunition, being ammunition for a weapon the possession of which by him is lawfully authorized.

"(3) Subject to the Ordinance and these Regulations, a person who holds an Explosives Licence (Purchase and Possession) shall not—

- (a) purchase in the prescribed area an explosive that he is not permitted by that licence to purchase;
- (b) purchase in the prescribed area a greater quantity of an explosive than he is permitted by that licence to purchase;
- (c) possess in the prescribed area an explosive that he is not permitted by that licence to possess; or
- (d) possess in the prescribed area a greater quantity of an explosive than he is permitted by that licence to possess.

"(4) Subject to the Ordinance and these Regulations, a person in the prescribed area shall not pass possession of an explosive or of a quantity of an explosive to a person who is not lawfully authorized to take possession of that explosive or of that quantity of that explosive.

"(5) The holder of an Explosives Licence (Selling) shall not sell an explosive, other than small arms ammunition, being ammunition for a weapon the possession of which by the purchaser is lawfully authorized, in the prescribed area to a person other than a person who holds a licence.

"(6) The holder of an Explosives Licence (Selling) shall not, in the prescribed area, sell to the holder of an Exposives Licence (Purchase and Possession)—

- (a) an explosive that that person is not permitted to purchase; or
- (b) a greater quantity of an explosive than that person is permitted to purchase.".
