FISH AND FISHERIES (SURRENDER OF GILL-NETTING) REGULATIONS

1. EXPIRATION

These Regulations shall expire on 1 January 1983.

2. SURRENDER OF UNITS OF GILL-NETTING

- (1) The holder of a Class Al licence for the Barramundi Fishery may, before 4 September 1982, in a form approved by the Director of Fisheries, apply to the Director of Fisheries to surrender the licence or a unit of gill-netting (within the meaning of the Fish and Fisheries Regulations) to which the licence relates.
- (2) The Director of Fisheries may, in his discretion, accept the surrender of the licence or unit of gill-netting and -

Fish and Fisheries (Surrender of Gill-netting) Regulations

- (a) in the case of the surrender of the licence pay to the applicant \$1,000 for each unit of gill-netting to which the licence relates; and
- (b) in the case of the surrender of a unit of gill-netting - pay to the applicant \$1,000 for the unit of gill-netting surrendered and endorse on the licence the variation resulting from the surrender of that unit.
