Regulations under the Fish and Fisheries Act

AMENDMENT OF THE FISH AND FISHERIES REGULATIONS

1. NEW REGULATION

This Fish and Fisheries Regulations are amended by adding after Division 2 in Part VI the following new division:

"Division 3 — Fish Reserve

59. DOCTORS GULLY FISH RESERVE

- (1) A person shall not fish for or take fish in the Doctors Gully Fish Reserve. Penalty: \$1,000.
- (2) Neither the Administrator, a minister nor any other person shall grant to any person any title to land in, or any licence or other right in relation to land in, the Doctors Gully Fish Reserve.
- (3) A person shall not, in the Doctors Gully Fish Reserve, carry on any activity that he is entitled to carry on by reason of a licence or other right that has been granted to him.

Penalty: \$1,000.".
