Regulations under the *Fish and Fisheries Act*

AMENDMENTS OF THE FISH AND FISHERIES REGULATIONS

1. PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

In these Regulations the Fish and Fisheries Regulations are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. MARY RIVER FISH MANAGEMENT ZONE

Regulation 7AA(1) of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after "Zone" the words "or had in possession (wherever taken) in the Management Zone".

3. ILLEGAL CRABBING

Regulation 16(1) of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting "that the licensee shall mark with a consecutive number each pot he is licensed to use and".

4. TRANSFER OF LICENCES

Regulation 19 is amended -

- (a) by omitting subregulation (1);

6 REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

The Principal Regulations are amended by repealing regulation 23A and substituting the following:

"23A. SURRENDER OF LICENCE

"(1) The Director shall, in pursuance of a buy-back scheme determined by the Minister, offer, in the manner determined, the sum of \$60,000 to the holder of a Class A1 licence endorsed with 10 units of gill-netting in consideration of the surrender of the licence.

"(2) The Director shall not accept the surrenders of more than 5 licences under subregulation (1).

"(3) The Director shall not accept any acceptance made by a licensee after 31 December 1988.

"(4) Notwithstanding the surrender of a licence, the person who was the licensee remains liable for -

(a) an act or omission done, caused, permitted or made by him; and

(b) all liabilities incurred by him under the Act, whilst he was licensed."

7. LEVY

The Principal Regulations are amended by omitting regulation 23B(3) and substituting the following:

"(3) The levy shall be applied in defraying the costs -

(a) of purchasing licences pursuant to regulation 23A; and

(b) of purchasing licences and units of gill-netting pursuant to any buy-back scheme instituted before the commencement of this regulation."

8. FEES FOR PROCESSING FOR EXPORT REDUCED

Regulation 51 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting from the item in the Table relating to the making of an endorsement on a Class B licence the expression "1,100" and substituting "50".
