

Regulations under the *Hospitals and Medical Services Ordinance 1953-1964.*

I, ROGER LEVINGE DEAN, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, having received the advice of the Administrator's Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the *Hospitals and Medical Services Ordinance 1953-1964* and the *Administrator's Council Ordinance 1959-1963*, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENTS OF THE HOSPITALS AND MEDICAL SERVICES
(CHARGES) REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 6 of the Hospitals and Medical Services (Charges) Regulations is amended by omitting the word "Schedule" (first occurring) and inserting in its stead the words "First Schedule". Charges for dental treatment.

2. Regulation 7 of the Hospitals and Medical Services (Charges) Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

"7. The charge for a medical service provided for an out-patient, being a service specified in the second column of the Second Schedule to these Regulations, is the amount specified in the third column of that Schedule opposite to that service." Charges for specified medical services.

3. The Schedule to the Hospitals and Medical Services (Charges) Regulations is amended by omitting from the heading to that Schedule the words— The Schedules.

and inserting in their stead the words—
