

Regulations under the *Justices Ordinance* 1928-1964

AMENDMENTS OF THE JUSTICES REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 5 of the Justices Regulations is amended by inserting after the word "document" the words "in criminal proceedings". Witnesses' expenses.

2. Form 63 in the Schedule to the Justices Regulations is amended— Amendment of Form 63.

- (a) by omitting the words "at the first sittings" and inserting in their stead the words "at the sittings";
- (b) by omitting the words "a sitting" and inserting in their stead the word "sittings"; and
- (c) by omitting the words "has been set down" and inserting in their stead the words "have been set down".
