MOTOR ACCIDENTS (COMPENSATION) RATES  
OF BENEFIT REGULATIONS

1. CITATION

These Regulations may be cited as the *Motor Accidents (Compensation) Rates of Benefit Regulations*.

2. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on the commencement of the *Motor Accidents (Compensation) Amendment Act (No. 2) 1984*.

3. LOSS OF LIMB, &c.

For the purposes of section 17 of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$50,000.

4. MEDICAL AND REHABILITATION EXPENSES

For the purposes of section 18(5) of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$50,000.

5. DEATH BENEFITS

For the purposes of section 22 of the Act, the prescribed maximum amount is \$45,000, the prescribed minimum amount is \$6,000 and the prescribed amount is \$15.

6. DEATH OF DEPENDENT SPOUSE

For the purposes of section 23 of the Act, the prescribed minimum amount is \$6,000 and the prescribed maximum amount is \$45,000.

7. DEPENDENT PARENTS BENEFIT

For the purposes of section 24 of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$25.

8. DEPENDENT CHILDREN'S BENEFIT

For the purposes of section 25 of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$25.

9. FUNERAL BENEFITS

For the purposes of section 26 of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$650.
