AMENDMENTS OF THE MINERAL OIL AND COAL REGULATIONS
1923†

1. Regulation 1 of the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended by omitting the words "Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923" and inserting in their stead the words "Coal Regulations". Citation
2. Regulation 2 of the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended— Definitions
 - (a) by omitting from the definition of "Lease" the words "Mineral Oil Lease or a"; and
 - (b) by omitting from the definition of "Lessee" the words "Mineral Oil Lease or a".
3. Regulation 3 of the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended— Applications for licences
 - (a) by omitting the words "mineral oil or coal or both mineral oil and";
 - (b) by omitting sub-paragraph (iii) of paragraph (a); and
 - (c) by omitting sub-paragraph (iii) of paragraph (b).
4. Regulation 5 of the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended— No restriction on other mining
 - (a) by omitting the word "prospector" and inserting in its stead the word "person"; and
 - (b) by omitting the words "mineral oil or".
5. Regulation 8 of the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended by omitting the words "Mineral Oil Leases and" Form of application

- (a) by omitting sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (a); and
- (b) by omitting sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (b).

8. Regulation 14 of the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended by omitting the words "Mineral Oil Leases or".

9. Regulation 15 of the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended—

- (a) by omitting the words—
"Application for Mineral Oil Leases—£20 for each block of 160 acres";
and
- (b) by omitting the words "and Mineral Oil Reward Leases".

10. Regulation 16 of the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is repealed.

11. Regulation 19 of the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended by omitting the words "Two pounds ten shillings" and inserting in their stead the words "two and one-half".

16. Form A in the Schedule to the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended—

- (a) by omitting from the title the words "MINERAL OIL OR COAL OR BOTH MINERAL OIL AND";
- (b) by omitting the words "mineral oil or coal or both mineral oil and" (wherever occurring);
- (c) by omitting the words "(in respect of which the mineral oil and coal therein are reserved, or belong to, the Crown),"; and
- (d) by omitting the words "Minister of State for Home and Territories".

Form B

17. Form B in the Schedule to the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended by omitting the words "mineral oil and".

18. Form C in the Schedule to the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended— **Form C**

- (a) by omitting the words "apply for a (b) lease" and inserting in their stead the words "apply for a coal lease";
- (b) by omitting sidenote (b); and
- (c) by omitting the statutory declaration form.

19. Form D in the Schedule to the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended— **Form D**

- (a) by omitting the words "for a (a) lease" and inserting in their stead the words "for a coal lease";
- (b) by omitting the words "mineral oil or" (wherever occurring); and
- (c) by omitting both sidenotes.

20. The Schedule to the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended by omitting Form E. **Form E**

21. Form F in the Schedule to the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended— **Form F**

- (a) by omitting the words "of State for Home and Territories of the Commonwealth of Australia (hereinafter called 'the Minister' which expression shall be deemed to include his successors in office the Minister of State or the member of the Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Australia for the time being administering the *Mineral Oil and Coal Ordinance 1922-1923*"); and
- (b) by omitting the words "and on the plan deposited in the Northern Territory Lands Office at Melbourne".

22. The Schedule to the Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 is amended by omitting Form G. **Form G**

23. The Mineral Oil and Coal Regulations 1923 are amended as set out in the Schedule to these Regulations. **Amendments in relation to decimal currency**
