AMENDMENTS OF THE BY-LAWS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF DARWIN†

1. The preliminary provision of the By-laws of the Municipality of Preliminary Darwin is amended by omitting the figures "13.13" and inserting in their stead the figures "13.26".

2. By-law 13.01 of the By-laws of the Municipality of Darwin is Definitions amended by omitting from the definition of "parking" the words "or waiting".

3. By-law 13.04 of the By-laws of the Municipality of Darwin is amended by omitting from clauses (2), (3), (4) and (5) the words "stop or park" and inserting in their stead the words "park or leave standing".

Prohibition of standing or parking in certain places

4. By-law 13.08 of the By-laws of the Municipality of Darwin is amended by omitting the words "leave any vehicle or motor vehicle parked or stationary" and inserting in their stead the words "park or leave standing a vehicle or motor vehicle".

Space between vehicles

5. By-law 13.26 of the By-laws of the Municipality of Darwin is Offences amended by adding at the end thereof the following clause:—

"(2) Section 354A of the Local Government Ordinance 1954 as amended applies to and in relation to any offence within the meaning of that section of contravening or failing to comply with by-law 13.04, 13.05, 13.06, 13.08, 13.11, 13.13 or 13.14 of these By-laws."

6. By-laws 13.27, 13.28, 13.29, 13.30 and 13.31 of the By-laws of Repeal the Municipality of Darwin are repealed.
