AMENDMENTS TO THE BY-LAWS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF DARWIN

The By-laws of the Municipality are amended by adding after By-law 26.05, Chapter 17, the following By-laws:

CHAPTER 18

REGISTRATION OF DOGS

Definitions	By-law 27.01
Registration of Dogs	By-laws 27.02—27.05

27.01 In this chapter, unless the contrary intention appears—

Definitions

“Dog” includes a female as well as a male dog;

“the Ordinance” means the *Registration of Dogs Ordinance* 1938-1968;

“Registrar” means the Town Clerk for the time being of the Council of the Corporation of the City of Darwin;

“Registered” means registered in the register;

“the register” means the register kept by the Registrar in accordance with By-law 27.02 (b).

27.02

(a) Any person residing in the Municipality of Darwin desiring to register a dog to be kept in the Municipality shall himself or by his agent give to the Registrar a description in writing

of the dog and a declaration in accordance with the form in the First Schedule to these By-laws, and shall pay to the Registrar a fee of Three dollars;

Provided that, half only of the prescribed fee shall be payable for the registration of a dog effected between the first day of January and the following thirtieth day of June.

Provided further that, where the owner of a registered dog which has died acquires another dog in the year ending the thirtieth day of June next following the date of the death of the registered dog he may register the other dog without payment or registration fee for that year.

- (b) The Registrar shall enter the particulars provided under paragraph (a) on a register kept by him for the purpose of recording such particulars and give to the person or his agent a receipt for the sum paid, in accordance with the form in the Second Schedule to these By-laws and if demanded, a copy, certified under his hand, of the description of the dog so registered, for which copy the sum of 10 cents shall be paid to the Registrar.

27.03 Upon compliance with By-law 27.02 by any person registering a dog, the dog shall, subject to these By-laws and the Ordinance, be a registered dog until the thirtieth day of June next following the registration.

Transfer of

27.04 When any change takes place in the ownership of a registered dog, the dog shall be deemed to be unregistered after the expiration of a period of 14 days from the date on which the change of ownership took place unless, within that period the new owner of the dog gives to the Registrar notice of being the new owner and the particulars of the dog indicated in the First Schedule to these By-laws.

- (a) The Registrar shall keep in some convenient part of his office during office hours for public inspection, a correct list, arranged in alphabetical order, of the names of the persons who have registered dogs with him during the current year, and showing the number of dogs registered by each person.
- (b) Any person applying for a certified copy of the description of any dog registered and of the name of the owner thereof, shall be entitled to receive the same on payment to the Registrar of a fee of 10 cents.
