MARINE (COLLISION) REGULATIONS

1. CITATION

These Regulations may be cited as the Marine (Collision) Regulations.

2. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Minister by notice in the Gazette.

3. INTERPRETATION

In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears "Code" means the Uniform Code and includes appendices thereto;
"Schedule" means the Schedule to section 16 of the Code;

Marine (Collision) Regulations

"vessel" has the meaning given to it in rule 3 in the Schedule;

4. COLLISION RULES

The rules and requirements set out in the Schedule shall apply in relation to a vessel to which Part IV, Division 6 of the Act applies, and to the master, mate and each person responsible for the navigation or working of that vessel.
