Regulations under the *Methylated Spirit Ordinance* 1936–1964

METHYLATED SPIRIT REGULATIONS

Citation.

Commencement.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Methylated Spirit Regulations.
- 2. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of September, 1965.
- Addition of colouring matter to methylated spirit.

3. Powdered aniline dye (methyl violet) shall be added to methylated spirit which is manufactured in, or brought or imported into, the Territory after the date on which these Regulations come into operation and which contains pyridine, in the proportion of not less than one-fortieth part of one ounce by weight of powdered dye to one hundred gallons of a mixture of spirit.
