AMENDMENT OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES (REGISTRATION LABELS AND MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS†

Affixing of
registration
labels

Regulation 7 of the Motor Vehicles (Registration Labels and Miscellaneous) Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (2.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

“(a) in the case of a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle) having a windscreen—the label shall be affixed—

- (i) on the inside or back of the windscreen in such a position that the centre of the label is not more than six inches from the bottom left hand or near side corner of the windscreen and so that the front of the label faces towards the front of the motor vehicle; or
- (ii) on the inner side of the pivoted or hinged ventilation window (if any) adjacent to the left hand or near side of the windscreen.”.
