AMENDMENTS OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) REGULATIONS

1. The First Schedule to the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Regulations is First Schedule repealed and the following Schedule substituted:

1	PRIVATE MOTOR CAR—A motor car, not included in Classes 5 to 11, both inclusive, that is used solely as set out in one or more of the following paragraphs:	\$
	(a) for social, domestic or pleasure purposes	
	(b) by the owner, being an individual, for his own carriage in relation to his profession, business or calling, not being the profession, business or calling of a commercial traveller or travelling salesman, or an insurance agent, canvasser, inspector, or assessor, or an indent, manufacturer's, stock and station, business or real estate agent	
	(c) by a medical practitioner for the purposes of his profession	
	(d) by or on behalf of the owner, being a primary producer	
	(e) in connexion with the work of a hospital, institution or trade union, by or on behalf of the authority controlling the hospital, institution or union	100.20
2	BUSINESS CAR—A motor car not included in Class 1 or in Classes 4 to 11, both inclusive	100.20

	(a) where the vehicle has seating accommodation for more than 6 adult persons (including the driver)	290.40
	(b) where the vehicle has seating accommodation for not more than 6 adult persons (including the driver)	100.20
5	PUBLIC HIRE CAR—A motor car, not included in Class 4 or 7, that stands in a public street for hire and in respect of which payment is received for the conveyance of passengers	309.60
6	PRIVATE HIRE CAR—A motor car, not included in Class 4 or 7, that does not stand in a public place for hire but in respect of which payment is received for the conveyance of passengers	147.80
7	DRIVE YOURSELF VEHICLE—A motor vehicle that is let for hire (otherwise than under a hire purchase agreement) without the services of a driver but does not stand in a public street for hire	290.40
