## Regulations under the Motor Vehicles Ordinance 1949-1968

## AMENDMENT OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) REGULATIONS†

- 1. These Regulations shall come into operation on the fifth day of Commencement March 1969.
- 2. The First Schedule to the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) The First Regulations is repealed and the following Schedule inserted in its stead:—

PRIVATE MOTOR CAR.—Any motor car, not included in Classes 5 to 11, both inclusive, which is used solely as set out in one or more of the following paragraphs:—

- (a) for social, domestic or pleasure purposes
- (b) by the owner, being an individual, for his own carriage in relation to his profession, business or calling; provided such profession, business or calling is not that of a commercial traveller or travelling salesman, or an insurance agent, canvasser, inspector, or assessor, or an indent, manufacturer's, stock, station, land or estate agent
- (c) by a medical practitioner for the purposes of his profession
- (d) by or on behalf of the owner, being a primary producer
