AMENDMENT OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) REGULATIONS[†]

Commencement

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of March, 1967.

Repeal

2. Regulation 18 of the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations is repealed.
