

Regulations under the *Motor Vehicles Ordinance* 1949-1966

AMENDMENT OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) REGULATIONS†

Commencement

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of March, 1967.

Repeal

2. Regulation 18 of the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations is repealed.

3. The First Schedule to the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Regulations is repealed and the following Schedule inserted in its stead:—

THE FIRST SCHEDULE PREMIUM CLASSIFICATION

No.	Class of Vehicle	Premium \$
1	PRIVATE MOTOR CAR.—Any motor car, not included in Classes 5 to 11, both inclusive, which is used solely as set out in one or more of the following paragraphs:— (a) for social, domestic or pleasure purposes (b) by the owner, being an individual, for his own carriage in relation to his profession, business or calling; provided such profession, business or calling is not that of a commercial traveller or travelling salesman, or an insurance agent, canvasser, inspector, or assessor, or an indent, manufacturer's, stock, station, land or estate agent (c) by a medical practitioner for the purposes of his profession (d) by or on behalf of the owner, being a primary producer

7	DRIVE YOURSELF VEHICLE. —Any motor vehicle which is let for hire (otherwise than under a hire purchase agreement) without the services of a driver but which does not stand in a public street for hire	37.71
8	MOTOR CYCLE. —Any motor vehicle, not included in Class 11 which has less than four wheels and is steered by means of a handle bar or tiller— (a) where the capacity rating of the engine of the motor cycle exceeds 250 cubic centimetres ..	22.38

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TRACTOR AND MISCELLANEOUS.—

- (a) any tractor and any motor vehicle, not included in Class 9, 11 or 12 which comprises an excavator, road grader, tar boiler, street flusher, chaff-cutter, crane or other machinery or apparatus and which is not constructed principally for the conveyance of persons or goods 7.05
- (b) any motor vehicle not otherwise classified in this schedule 7.05".

4. The Second Schedule to the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Regulations is amended by omitting Forms O and P and inserting in their stead the following Forms:—
