AMENDMENTS OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 December 1981.

2. SCHEDULE

The Schedule to the Motor Vehicles Regulations is amended -

(a) by omitting the back of Form B and substituting the following:

"CLASSIFICATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

- CLASS A Private motor car, motor lorry or motor tractor, the gross vehicle mass of which does not exceed 4.5 tonnes
- CLASS C Private motor car, motor lorry or motor tractor
- CLASS E1 A motor cycle the engine capacity of which does not exceed 250 cubic centimetres

Motor Vehicles Regulations

- CLASS E2 A motor cycle the engine capacity of which does not exceed 600 cubic centimetres
- CLASS E3 Any motor cycle"; and
- (b) by omitting the back of Form C and substituting the following:

"CLASSIFICATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

- CLASS A Private motor car, motor lorry or motor tractor, the gross vehicle mass of which does not exceed 4.5 tonnes
- CLASS B Private motor car, motor lorry, motor tractor, private hire car or public hire car, the gross vehicle mass of which does not exceed 4.5 tonnes
- CLASS C Private motor car, motor lorry or motor tractor
- CLASS D Any motor vehicle other than a private hire car, public hire car or motor cycle
- CLASS E1 A motor cycle the engine capacity of which does not exceed 250 cubic centimetres
- CLASS E2 A motor cycle the engine capacity of which does not exceed 600 cubic centimetres
- CLASS E3 Any motor cycle".
