NATIONAL PARKS AND GARDENS
(ELLERY CREEK BIG HOLE) BY-LAWS

- Citation** 1. These By-laws may be cited as the National Parks and Gardens (Ellery Creek Big Hole) By-laws.
- Definitions** 2. In these By-laws, "the Reserve" means the land that was committed to the care, control and management of the Board by notice in *Northern Territory Government Gazette* No. 36 of 1968 dated 14 August, 1968.
- Fires** 3. A person shall not light a wood fire on the Reserve except in a fireplace provided by the Board.
Penalty: One hundred dollars.
