AMENDMENT OF THE NATIONAL PARKS AND GARDENS (BERRY SPRINGS RECREATION RESERVE) BY-LAWS

By-law 3 of the National Parks and Gardens (Berry Springs Recreation Reserve) By-laws is repealed.

*Notified in the *Northern Territory Government Gazette* on 13 June, 1975.
