By-laws under the *National Parks and Gardens Ordinance 1959-1968*

The Northern Territory Reserves Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by the *National Parks and Gardens Ordinance 1959-1968*, at a meeting held on the fifteenth day of July 1970, made the following By-laws.

AMENDMENT OF NATIONAL PARKS AND GARDENS (HOWARD SPRINGS RECREATION RESERVE) BY-LAWS†

By-law 3 of the National Parks and Gardens (Howard Springs Recreation Reserve) By-laws is hereby repealed and the following new By-law inserted in its stead:

- "3. (a) The Reserve is open to the public only during the following hours:
- (i) Upon any day from Monday to Friday inclusive (not being a public holiday) between the hours of seven o'clock in the morning and nine o'clock in the evening.
 - (ii) Upon any Saturday, Sunday or public holiday between the hours of seven o'clock in the morning and ten o'clock in the evening.
- (b) In this By-law the words "public holiday" mean any public holiday or bank holiday specified in the schedule to the *Holidays Ordinance 1957-1967* and any other public holiday or bank holiday notified pursuant to that Ordinance in respect of the whole of the Northern Territory or any part of the Northern Territory as is to the North of latitude 15 degrees."
