

Regulations under the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1928-1962*

AMENDMENTS OF THE NURSING REGULATIONS†

Period of training

1. Regulation 12 of the Nursing Regulations is amended—
 - (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "four years" and inserting in their stead the words "three years"; and
 - (b) by omitting sub-regulation (2.).

Amendments in relation to decimal currency

2. The Nursing Regulations are amended as set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.
