

**Regulations under the *Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Ordinance 1954-1966***

**AMENDMENTS OF THE PETROLEUM (PROSPECTING AND MINING) REGULATIONS†**

Applications  
for permit

1. Regulation 3 of the Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

“3.—(1.) An application for a permit by an individual shall be in accordance with Form 1.

“(2.) An application for a permit by an association of individuals or bodies corporate or of individuals and bodies corporate shall be in accordance with Form 4.

“(3.) Each member of the association shall make a declaration in Form 4A or 4B as the case may require and each declaration so made shall be lodged with the application and shall be deemed to be incorporated in and form part of the application.

“(4.) An application for a permit by a body corporate shall be in accordance with Form 7.

“(5.) An application for a permit in accordance with Form 1, 4 or 7 shall be in duplicate and shall be accompanied by two copies of a plan and description of the land applied for.

“(6.) A statement such as required by section 25 of the Ordinance in support of an application for a permit or an extension of a permit may be—

- (a) in the case of an application by an individual—in accordance with Form 2;
- (b) in the case of an application by an association of individuals or bodies corporate or of individuals and bodies corporate—in accordance with Form 4C; and
- (c) in the case of an application by a body corporate—in accordance with Form 7A.”.

2. Regulations 4 and 4A of the Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Regulations are repealed.

Repeal of regulations 4 and 4A

3. Regulation 5 of the Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

“5.—(1.) An application for a lease by an individual shall be in accordance with Form 3.

Applications for leases

“(2.) An application for a lease by an association of persons or of bodies corporate or of persons and bodies corporate shall be in accordance with Form 6 and shall be accompanied by a declaration in Form 6A or 6B made by each member of the association as the case may require and each declaration so made shall be lodged with the application and be deemed to be incorporated in and form part of the application.

“(3.) An application for a lease by a body corporate shall be in accordance with Form 9.

“(4.) An application for a lease in accordance with Form 3, 6 or 9 shall be in duplicate and shall be accompanied by two copies of a plan and description of the land applied for, each plan and description being in accordance with a survey made by a surveyor approved by the Administrator for the purposes of these Regulations.”.

4. Regulation 6 of the Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

“6.—(1.) A person shall not furnish to the Administrator an application for a permit or lease which contains a statement which is false in any particular.

Penalty: One hundred dollars.

“(2.) A person shall not furnish to the Administrator or make a declaration which is false in any particular.

Penalty: Two hundred dollars.

“(3.) A person shall not fail to do what he has undertaken to do in any undertaking given by him in any declaration or application made under the Ordinance or these Regulations.

Penalty: Two hundred dollars.”.

5. Regulation 7 of the Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Regulations is amended by omitting the word “, licence”.

6. Regulation 9 of the Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Regulations is amended by omitting the words “Twenty pounds.” and inserting in their stead the words “Forty dollars.”.

7. Regulations 10, 11 and 12 of the Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Regulations are repealed and the following regulations inserted in their stead:—

“10. An application for the waiver, suspension or reduction of rent or royalty, or rent and royalty, shall be supported by a Statutory Declaration setting out the facts relied on by the applicant to show that the waiver, suspension or reduction is applied for in order to promote the development of the lease or because the lease cannot be successfully operated under the terms provided for in the lease.

“11. An application by a permittee or lessee for the suspension of obligations under his permit or lease shall be supported by a Statutory Declaration verifying the grounds of the application.

“12. An application by a permittee or lessee for the variation of the terms and conditions of his permit or lease shall be supported by a Statutory Declaration verifying the grounds of the application.”.

8. Regulation 15 of the Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Regulations is amended by—

(a) omitting from sub-regulation (1.)—

- (i) the word “, licensee”;
- (ii) the word “licence” (wherever occurring); and
- (iii) the words “Fifty pounds.” and inserting in their stead “One hundred dollars.”; and

(b) omitting from sub-regulation (2.)—

- (i) the word “licence”;
- (ii) the word “licensee”; and
- (iii) the words “Fifty pounds.” and inserting in their stead the words “One hundred dollars.”.

9. After regulation 17 the following regulations are inserted:—

“18. The prescribed fee for the registration of a dealing in relation to a permit or lease, or any rights arising from a permit or lease, is Five dollars.

- (a) an entry in the Register of Permits or Register of Leases; or
  - (b) a registered document,
- shall be one dollar per page or part thereof of such entry or registered document.

“20. The prescribed fee in respect of an application for the consent of the Administrator under section 72 of the Ordinance is Five dollars.”.

10. The Schedule to the Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Regulations is amended by omitting Forms 1, 2, 4, 5, 5A, 5B, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 17, 19, 21, 25 and 33.

Notwithstanding the preceding provisions of these Regulations where, after the commencement of the *Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Ordinance* 1966, the holder of a permit or licence issued or granted and in force before the commencement of that Ordinance becomes, in pursuance of sub-section (1.) of section 50 of that Ordinance, the holder of a licence or lease subject to the provisions of the *Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Ordinance* 1954-1964, the regulations made and in force under the last-mentioned Ordinance before the commencement of the *Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Ordinance* 1966 continue to apply to and in relation to that last-mentioned licence or lease.
