

Regulations under the *Prohibited Drugs Ordinance* 1963

PROHIBITED DRUGS REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prohibited Drugs Regulations. Citation
2. The Schedule to the *Prohibited Drugs Ordinance* 1963 is amended Amendment of
by omitting the words— Schedule to
 - "Thalidomide.
 - Ketobemidone.
 - Diamorphine (Heroin) and the salts of the drug Diamorphine (Heroin)."Ordinance
- and inserting in their stead the words—
 - "Allylisopropylacetyl urea
 - Amidopyrine (aminopyrine) and derivatives of the drug amidopyrine (aminopyrine), including dipyrone
 - Diamorphine (heroin) and the salts of the drug diamorphine (heroin)
 - Ketobemidone
 - Methyl cinchophen (methyl ester of phenylcinchoninic acid)
 - Thalidomide".
3. Regulation 1964, No. 6, is repealed. Repeal
