AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH
(BARBERS' SHOPS) REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 January 1983.

2. REGISTRATION OF BARBERS' SHOPS

Regulation 5(6) of the Public Health (Barbers' Shops) Regulations is amended by omitting "one dollar" and substituting "\$25".

3. FURTHER AMENDMENTS

The Public Health (Barbers' Shop) Regulations are further amended as set out in the Schedule.
