

Regulations under the *Petroleum Products Subsidy Ordinance 1965*

AMENDMENT OF THE PETROLEUM PRODUCTS SUBSIDY REGULATIONS†

Equivalents
in decimal
currency

1. The Petroleum Products Subsidy Regulations are amended by adding at the end thereof the following regulation:—

“3.—(1.) Subject to the next succeeding sub-regulation, the equivalents in the currency provided for by the *Currency Act 1965* of the rates of payment specified in the schedule to the scheme formulated by the Minister under section 4 of the *Petroleum Products Subsidy Ordinance 1965* shall be ascertained on the basis that the amount of money in the currency so provided for that corresponds to one penny in the currency provided for by the *Coinage Act 1909-1947* is five-sixths of a cent.

“(2.) Where an equivalent rate in the currency provided for by the *Currency Act 1965* of a rate specified in the schedule to the scheme, calculated in accordance with the last preceding sub-regulation, is not an amount of cents, or cents and tenths of a cent, without remainder, the equivalent rate shall—

- (a) if the remainder is less than five-hundredths of a cent—be deemed to be reduced by the amount of the remainder; and
- (b) if the remainder is, or exceeds, five-hundredths of a cent—be increased by treating the remainder as one-tenth of a cent.”.
