Regulations under the *Public Service Ordinance* 1928-1968

I, ROGER LEVINGE DEAN, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, having received the advice of the Administrator's Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the *Public Service Ordinance* 1928-1968 and the *Administrator's Council Ordinance* 1959-1963, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS†

1. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on **Commencement:** the seventeenth day of July, 1969.

2. Regulation 31 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulations (1.) and (1A.) and inserting in their stead the following sub-regulations:— **Salaries**

"(1.) Except as hereinafter provided an officer other than an officer of the Police Branch, the Prisons Branch, the Fire Services Branch, or the Department of the Legislative Council shall be paid a salary at such annual rate as is specified in the following table within the limits of the scale of rates of annual salary fixed in respect of his office:—

(1A.) An officer of the Department of the Legislative Council shall be paid a salary at such annual rate as is specified in the following table within the scale of rates of annual salary fixed in respect of his office:—

- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the figures "\$6533" and inserting in their stead the figures "\$7219"; and
 (b) by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the figures "\$6131" and inserting in their stead the figures "\$6817".

Allowance for conveyance

4. Regulation 59 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting the table from sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following table:—

5. Regulation 66 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting the table from sub-regulation (8.) and inserting in its stead the following table:—
