

## Regulations under the *Public Service Ordinance*

**I** JOHN NORMAN NELSON, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, having received the advice of the Administrator's Council, and, in relation to officers of the Department of the Legislative Council, on the recommendation of the President of the Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Public Service Ordinance* in relation to all officers.

### AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS

1. Regulation 4 of the Public Service Regulations is repealed. Repeal of regulation 4
  
2. Regulation 16 of the Public Service Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted: Use of Service information

"16. An officer shall not use for a purpose, other than for the discharge of his official duties, information gained by, or conveyed to, him through his connexion with the Service."
  
3. Regulation 31 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulations (1), (1A), (1B) and (1c) and substituting the following sub-regulations: Salaries

"(1) For the purposes of section 9 of the Ordinance, an officer of the Department of the Administrator shall, subject to this regulation, be paid a salary in dollars at the annual rate specified in Table A or Table B in this sub-regulation, being the rate, or rate within the limits of the scale of rates, of salary that is applicable to his office having regard to its classification.

"(1A) For the purposes of section 9 of the Ordinance—

- (a) an officer of the Department of the Legislative Council shall, subject to this regulation, be paid a salary in dollars at the annual rate specified in the Table in this paragraph, being the rate, or rate within the limits of the scale of rates, of salary that is applicable to his office having regard to its classification.

- (b) notwithstanding the classification of such an office, the rate or scale of rates so specified shall be increased, with effect from and including 30 May 1974, on account of variations in the cost of living by an annual amount equal to the sum of—
- (i) 2 per cent of the rate or scale of rates so specified; and
- (ii) \$130.

"(1B) A Typist, Grade 1 shall be paid an allowance—

- (a) at the rate of \$152 per annum if he is not entitled to an allowance under paragraph (b) and he has passed a test conducted by or on behalf of the Administrator in typing at the rate of 50 words per minute and in typing letters and other documents with due regard to punctuation and form; or
- (b) at the rate per annum in dollars specified in the second column of the table in this paragraph in relation to the highest speed in words per minute specified in the first column of that table at which he has passed a test conducted by or on behalf of the Administrator in writing shorthand, being a test also is correctly transcribing that shorthand.

“(1c) A Steno-Secretary, Grade 2 who—

(a) has passed a test conducted by or on behalf of the Administrator in writing shorthand at a speed of 140 words a minute and in correctly transcribing that shorthand; and

(b) is required to take and transcribe notes of evidence in courts, or is employed on duties of a like nature,

shall be paid an allowance at the rate per annum that is equal to the difference between the rate at which salary is payable to her and \$7511 per annum”.

4. Regulation 42(1) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting “\$1.80” and substituting “\$2”.

Meal  
allowance

5.(1) Regulation 52(1)(a) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting “\$19.65” and substituting “\$22.50”.

Travelling  
allowance

(2) Regulation 52(1)(b) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting “\$14.75” and substituting “\$17”.

(3) The rates of travelling allowance provided by regulation 52 of the Public Service Regulations as amended by sub-regulations (1) and (2) apply in relation to the service of an officer or temporary employee on and after 30 May 1974.
