Regulations under the *Public Service Ordinance* 1928-1968

AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 31 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by Salaries omitting sub-regulation (1A.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:—

"(1i..) For the purposes of section 9 of the Public Service Ordinance 1928-1968, the rate of annual salary, or the scale of rates of annual salary, payable to an officer who occupies an office in the Department of the Legislative Council is, subject to this regulation, the rate, or scale of rates, specified in the table in this sub-regulation that is appropriate to the office having regard to its classification.

2. Regulation 51 of the Public Service Regulations is amended—

(a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the word "Members" and inserting in its stead the words "Subject to the next succeeding sub-regulation, members"; and

- (b) by inserting after sub-regulation (1.) the following sub-regulation:—
- "(1A.) An officer of the Department of the Legislative Council is not entitled to overtime if the officer is in receipt of a salary in excess of—
 - (a) in the case of a male officer \$7,670;
 - (b) in the case of a female officer \$7,242.".

Application

3. The President may authorise the payment of an allowance, in respect of the period from and including the first day of June, 1970, to and including the day immediately before the commencement of these Regulations, to each officer of the Department of the Legislative Council of such an amount as would result in the total remuneration of the efficer being not less than the total remuneration that would have been payable to the officer in respect of that period if the amendments made by these Regulations had taken effect on the first day of June, 1970.
