## REGULATIONS 1975. No. 25\*

## Regulations under the Public Service Ordinance

I, ERIC FRANCIS DWYER, the Acting Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, having received the advice of the Administrator's Council and, in relation to officers of the Department of the Legislative Assembly, on the recommendation of the Speaker of the Assembly, hereby make the following Regulations under the Public Service Ordinance in relation to all Officers.

## AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) Regulation 31 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by inserting Salaries before sub-regulation (1A) the following sub-regulation:
- "(1AA) Notwithstanding the classification of such an office, the rate or scale of rates specified in Table B in sub-regulation (1) that is applicable to an office shall be increased, with effect from and including 18 September, 1975, on account of variations in the cost of living by an annual amount equal to 3.5 per cent of the rate or scale of rates so specified.".
- (2) Regulation 31 (1A) (a) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting "\$161" and substituting "\$167".
- (3) Regulation 31 (1A) (b) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting the second column of the table in that paragraph and substituting the following column:

"Rate per annum

167 332

- (4) Regulation 31 (1B) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting "\$161" and substituting "\$167".
- 2. (1) Regulation 51 (1) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by Certain officers omitting all the words before "per annum" (second occurring) and substituting to overtime "Officers who are in receipt of a salary in excess of \$14,572".
- (2) Regulation 51 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (1A).
- 3. (1) A payment of salary to an officer made after 18 September-1975 and Savings before the commencement of these Regulations shall not be held to have been wrongly made by reason only that there was no rate specified in Table A of Table B in sub-regulation (1) that was applicable to the office occupied by the officer having regard to its classification.

(2) For the purposes of computing the amount payable to an officer, any reclassification of the office occupied by the officer after 18 September 1975 and before the commencement of these Regulations shall not be taken into account.
