

Regulations under the *Public Service Ordinance*

I, JOHN ARMSTRONG ENGLAND, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, having received the advice of the Administrator's Council and, in relation to officers of the Department of the Legislative Assembly, on the recommendation of the Speaker of the Assembly, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Public Service Ordinance* in relation to all officers.

AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS

1. Regulation 31 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by inserting after sub-regulation (1A) the following sub-regulation: Salaries

“(1AD) Notwithstanding the classification of such an office, the rate or scale of rates specified in Table B in sub-regulation (1) that is applicable to an office shall be further increased with effect from and including 19 August 1976, on account of variations in the cost of living, by an amount equal to—

- (a) in the case where a rate as increased up to but not including 19 August 1976 is not more than \$8,660, \$130; or
- (b) in the case where a rate as so increased is more than \$8,660, 1.5% of that rate as increased.”

2. Regulation 51 (1) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting “\$15,703” and substituting “\$15,939”.
