

Regulations under the *Public Service Ordinance*

I, JOHN ARMSTRONG ENGLAND, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, having received the advice of the Administrator's Council and, in relation to officers of the Department of the Legislative Assembly, on the recommendation of the Speaker of the Assembly, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Public Service Ordinance* in relation to all officers.

AMENDMENTS TO THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS

1.(1) Regulation 31 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by inserting Salaries after sub-regulation (1AD) the following sub-regulation:

“(1AE) Notwithstanding the classification of such an office, the rate or scale of rates specified in Table B in sub-regulation (1) that is applicable to an office shall be further increased with effect from and including 25 November 1976, on account of variations in the cost of living, by an amount equal to 2.2% of that rate or scale of rates as increased up to but not including 25 November.”.

(2) Regulation 31 (1A) (a) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting “\$178” and substituting “\$181”.

(3) Regulation 31 (1A) (b) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting the second column of the table in that paragraph and substituting the following column:

“Rate per annum \$

542”

(4) Regulation 31 (1B) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting “\$178” and substituting “\$181”.

2. Regulation 51 (1) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting “\$15,939” and substituting “\$16,290”. Certain officers not entitled to overtime
