

Regulation under the *Public Service Ordinance* 1928-1962.

AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS.†

Regulation 31A of the Public Service Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

Alteration to
classification
may have effect
retrospectively.

“31A. When the Minister alters a classification and is of the opinion that the alteration should have retrospective effect, he may direct that the holders of the offices reclassified shall be paid an allowance equivalent to the alteration in classification in respect of any period preceding the date of reclassification.”.
