Regulations under the Stock Routes and Travelling Stock Ordinance 1954–1963.

Amendments of the Stock Routes and Travelling Stock Regulations,†

1. Regulations 1964 No. 1 are repealed.

Repeal.

- 2. A reference in the succeeding provisions of these Regulations to the Interpretation. Stock Routes and Travelling Stock Regulations shall be read as a reference to Regulations 1956, No. 5, as amended by Regulations 1956, No. 15; 1960, Nos. 8 and 18; and 1962, No. 10.
- 3. Regulation 10 of the Stock Routes and Travelling Stock Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—
- "10.—(1.) In addition to the matters required by section 21 of the Additional matters to be shown on a permit, the permit shall contain—

 (2) a reference to the data area which the application for the Permit.
 - (a) a reference to the date upon which the application for the permit was made;
 - (b) the particulars of treatments referred to in the last preceding regulation;
 - (c) a condition as to the disposal of the permit on the completion of the journey to which it relates;
 - (d) where the stock will travel on the hoof on a stock route, the dates upon and the places at which the stock will respectively enter and leave the stock route to which the permit applies;

- (e) such other particulars as are required to be entered on a permit pursuant to these Regulations.
- (2.) A permit shall be in accordance with Form 1."

Disposal of straying stock.

- 4. Regulation 33 of the Stock Routes and Travelling Stock Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (4.).
- 5. After regulation 33 of the Stock Routes and Travelling Stock Regulations the following regulation is inserted:—

Fees for use of public trucking yards.

- "34.—(1.) Where public trucking yards are used in or in connexion with the transporting of stock, fees calculated in accordance with this regulation are payable by the owner of the stock in respect of which the public trucking yards are used.
- "(2.) No fees are payable under this regulation in respect of the use of public trucking yards in connexion with the transporting of stock numbering—
 - (a) where the stock are cattle or horses—fewer than twenty-five head of stock; or
 - (b) where the stock are sheep or goats—fewer than two hundred and fifty head of stock.
 - "(3.) The fees shall be calculated at the following rates:—
 - (a) where the stock are cattle or horses—Three pence for every head of stock;
 - (b) where the stock are sheep or goats—Three pence for every ten head of stock.
- "(4.) Where, in the course of a journey on which stock are transported by rail or road, use is made of—
 - (a) one set of public trucking yards more than once; or
 - (b) two or more sets of public trucking yards,

no fee is payable under this regulation except in respect of the use first made.

- "(5.) The Administrator may by writing direct that no fees shall be payable under this regulation in respect of the use of public trucking yards specified in the direction and, if he does so, no fees are payable in respect of such use accordingly.".
