AMENDMENTS OF THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS[†]

Commencement

Limitation of speeds

- 2. Regulation 32 of the Traffic Regulations is amended—
- (a) by omitting from paragraph (c) of sub-regulation (1.) the figures and words "30 miles per hour" and inserting in their stead the figures and words "35 miles per hour";

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on a date to be fixed

- (b) by omitting from sub-regulation (2.) the figures and words "30 miles per hour" and inserting in their stead the figures and words "35 miles per hour";
- (c) by inserting in sub-regulation (3.) after the words "town area" (twice occurring) the words "or within the boundaries of a municipality":
- (d) by omitting from sub-regulation (3.) the figures and words "30 miles per hour" and inserting in their stead the figures and words "35 miles per hour"; and
- (e) by omitting sub-regulation (4.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:----

"(4.) A public street that commences and terminates within a town area or within the boundaries of a municipality is a speed limit area.".
