Regulations under the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance

AMENDMENTS OF THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION REGULATIONS

1. Regulation 5 of the Workmen's Compensation Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:

"5. The fee payable to a medical practitioner or a medical referee for the provision of a medical service for the purposes of the *Workmen's Compensation Ordinance* shall be the fee for that medical service prescribed from time to time by the *National Health Act* 1953, in its application in the Northern Territory of Australia.".

2. Regulation 7 of the Workmen's Compensation Regulations is amended by inserting after "letter" the words ", addressed to him at his last known place of abode or business,".

3. Regulation 9 of the Workmen's Compensation Regulations is amended by omitting "100 dollars" and substituting "200 dollars".
