ADMINISTRATION AND PROBATE **ORDINANCE 1928-1940.***

An Ordinance to amend the Administration and Probate Act, 1891, of the State of South Australia, in its application to North Australia.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Administration and Short title. Probate Ordinance 1928-1940.*

1AA. In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention Definitions. appears:----

> "the Act" means the Administration and Probate Act, 1891, of the State of South Australia, in its application to the Territory.

1AB. Section twenty-six of the Act is amended by omitting Resealing of the words "of the other Australasian colonies, or in the United Kingdom" and inserting in their stead the words "portion of His Majesty's dominions".

1AC. Section twenty-eight of the Act is amended by omitting Foreign the words "an Australasian colony, or the United Kingdom" and administration. inserting in their stead the words "a portion of His Majesty's Inserted by dominions" dominions ".

1AD. Section twenty-nine of the Act is amended by omitting Definitions. the definitions of "Australasian colonies" and "United King-dom" and inserting in their stead the following definitions:—

" portion of His Majesty's dominions" includes any territory which is under His Majesty's protection or in respect of which a mandate under the League of Nations has been accepted by His Majesty;.

"VII. Where the deceased shall have died wholly or partially intestate, leaving estate within the Territory, and administration has not been granted within three months of the death of the deceased.".

2. Section One hundred and thirteen of the Act is amended by inserting, after the word "court", the words "or before a person whose name is entered in the Register of Practitioners kept at the Principal Registry of the High Court,".
