ADMINISTRATOR'S COUNCIL ORDINANCE 1959.* Amenaled 73/64

An Ordinance to confer certain powers on the Administrator in Council, and for other purposes.

- This Ordinance may be cited as the Administrator's short title. Council Ordinance 1959.*
- 2 This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be commencefixed by the Administrator by notice in the Gazette.†
 - 3. The Council of Advice Ordinance 1919 is repealed. Repeal.
- 4 In this Ordinance, "the Administrator's Council" means Definition. the Administrator's Council established under section four ZA of the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1959.
- 5 Where an Ordinance is expressed to confer power on the Regulation Administrator to make regulations, or where an Ordinance of North Australia is expressed to confer upon the Government Resident power to make regulations, the regulations may be made by the Administrator in Council.

6 The Ordinances specified in the first column of the First Amendment of Ordinances. Schedule to this Ordinance are amended as respectively specified in the second column of that Schedule.

7. Each Ordinance specified in the first column of the Citation of Second Schedule to this Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinances. nance, may be cited in the manner specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite the reference to that Ordinance in the first column.

8.—(1.) Subject to this section, where it is provided by this Exercis of or any other Ordinance that an act or thing shall or may be done of powers, &c., by the Administrator in Council, that act or thing shall or may, Administrator in Council. as the case may be, be done by the Administrator.

(2.) The Administrator's Council may advise the Administrator in respect of the doing of such an act or thing and the Administrator shall not do the act or thing until the Administrator has received the advice of the Administrator's Council.

The Administrator's Council Ordinance 1959 comprises the Administrator's Council Ordinance 1959 (No. 22 of 1959) as amended by the Licensing Ordinance 1959 (No. 12 of 1959) and the Stock Diseases Ordinance 1959 (No. 23 of 1959). The Administrator's Council Ordinance 1959 was assented to by the Administrator on 7th July, 1959, and commenced on 28th April, 1960. The Licensing Ordinance 1959 was assented to on 17th June, 1959, and commenced on 19th June, 1959. The Stock Diseases Ordinance 1959 was assented to and commenced on 23rd July, 1959.

- (3.) The Administrator, in doing such an act or thing, is not bound to act in conformity with the advice of the Administrator's Council.
- (4.) In the event of the Administrator acting contrary to or failing to act in accordance with the advice of the Administrator's Council, he shall, not later than the first sitting day of the next meeting of the Legislative Council, cause a statement of the reasons for his so acting or failing to act, as the case may be, to be laid before the Legislative Council.
