

CROWN LAW OFFICER REFERENCE ORDINANCE 1950.*

An Ordinance relating to references to the Crown Law Officer or Deputy Crown Solicitor.

**Short title
and citation.**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Crown Law Officer Reference Ordinance 1950*.*

Repeal.

2. The *Crown Law Officer Reference Ordinance 1942* is repealed.

3. Any reference in any Ordinance of the Territory, or in any regulations, by-laws, or other instrument made under such Ordinance, to the Crown Law Officer or the Deputy Crown Solicitor shall, in relation to anything done, or required or permitted to be done, after the commencement of this Ordinance, be read as a reference to the person from time to time holding, or performing the duties of, the office of Crown Law Officer and Draftsman in the Territory, established under the *Commonwealth Public Service Act 1922-1948*.
