

DARWIN RATES (WAR-TIME REMISSION) ORDINANCE 1943.*†

An Ordinance to provide for the Remission of Certain Rates on Land in the Town of Darwin.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Darwin Rates (War-time Remission) Ordinance 1943*.* Short title.

2.—(1.) Notwithstanding anything contained in the *Darwin Rates Ordinance 1937-1940*, an amount equal to one quarter (calculated to the nearest penny) of the rates payable in respect of any land in pursuance of the declaration of the Administrator under that Ordinance published in the *Gazette* on the twelfth day of December, One thousand nine hundred and forty-one is hereby remitted. Remission of one quarter of 1941/2 rates.

(2.) Where, in respect of any land, there has been paid as rates payable in respect of that land in consequence of that declaration any amount in excess of the rates so payable after taking into account the remission made by this Ordinance, that amount shall be refunded to the person who paid it, or, in special circumstances, to the person who, in the opinion of the Administrator, is justly entitled to receive the refund.
