

An Ordinance to provide for the Appointment of
a Sheriff of the Northern Territory.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Sheriff Ordinance* 1911.* Short title.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect on and after the date thereof.† Commencement.

3.—(1.) There shall be a Sheriff of the Northern Territory, who shall be appointed by the Governor-General, and shall hold office during his pleasure. Appointment.

(2.) Until a Sheriff of the Northern Territory is appointed, the Deputy Sheriff of the Northern Territory shall be the Sheriff of the Northern Territory, and shall hold office as if he had been appointed under this Ordinance.

4. The Sheriff of the Northern Territory shall have and may exercise or execute in the Northern Territory all the powers, functions, and duties of the Sheriff or of the Deputy Sheriff under the law in force in the Northern Territory immediately prior to the acceptance of that Territory by the Commonwealth. Powers and duties of Sheriff.
