An Act to Apply certain Sums of Money out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Year ending on the last day of June, 1907, and certain further Sums to the Service of the Year ended on the last day of June, 1906, and to appropriate the Supplies granted in the present Session of Parliament.

[ASSENTED TO 12TH DECEMBER, 1906.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,—

Preamble.

WE, your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to your Majesty in the present Session of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore beseech your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Appropriation.

[Schedules A,
B, C, and D.]

1. In addition to the several sums specified in the Schedules to this Bill marked respectively A, B, C, and D, and which sums are payable under the authority of the several Acts in those Schedules respectively mentioned, there shall and may be issued and applied, towards making good the supplies granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending on the last day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seven, the sums following, inclusive of the three several sums of Four hundred and eighty thousand pounds, Five hundred and forty thousand pounds, and One hundred thousand pounds already authorised to be applied towards the service of the year ending on the last day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seven, by "*The Appropriation Act of 1906-1907, No. 1,*" "*The Appropriation Act of 1906-1907, No. 2,*" and "*The Appropriation Act of 1906-1907, No. 3,*"* that is to say,—

From the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Queensland, exclusive of the moneys standing to the credit of the Loan Fund Account, the sum of Two million two hundred and two thousand six hundred and eighty-one pounds;

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From the Trust and Special Funds the sum of Two hundred and eighty-three thousand eight hundred and twenty-three pounds eighteen shillings and six pence ;

From the moneys standing to the credit of the Loan Fund Account the sum of Eight hundred and ninety thousand seven hundred and thirty-five pounds.

2. The sums granted by this Act and by "*The Appropriation Act of 1906-1907, No. 1,*" "*The Appropriation Act of 1906-1907, No. 2,*" and "*The Appropriation Act of 1906-1907, No. 3,*"* and which are set forth in the Schedules to this Act marked respectively F, G, and H, amounting, as appears by the said Schedules, in all to the sum of Three million three hundred and seventy-seven thousand two hundred and thirty-nine pounds eighteen shillings and six pence, are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and six, for the purposes and services expressed in the said Schedules F, G, and H, respectively.

Appropriation of sums voted for Supply services.

[Schedules F, G, and H.]

3. In addition to the several sums specified in the Schedule to this Act marked E, and which sums were lawfully paid for the service of the year ended on the last day of June, One thousand nine hundred and six, under the authority of the several Acts in that Schedule mentioned, there shall and may also be issued and applied the further sums following, that is to say,—

Supplementary Appropriation, 1905-1906.
[Schedule E.]

From the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Queensland, exclusive of the moneys standing to the credit of the Loan Fund Account, a further sum of Ninety-five thousand one hundred and twelve pounds fifteen shillings and eleven pence ;

From the Trust and Special Funds the sum of Thirty-five thousand nine hundred and fifty-six pounds twelve shillings and eleven pence ;

From the moneys standing to the credit of the Loan Fund Account a further sum of Seventeen thousand one hundred and eighty-four pounds ten shillings and two pence ;

to defray Supplementary Charges for the service of the said year ended on the last day of June, One thousand nine hundred and six, and such sums shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and five, for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedules to this Act marked I, K, and L.

[Schedules I, K, and L.]

Treasurer to pay moneys as directed by warrant.

4. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, to such persons, upon such days, and in such proportions as the Governor, by any warrant or order under his hand and directed to the Treasurer, from time to time orders and directs, and the payments so made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Queensland.

Treasurer to be allowed credit for sums paid in pursuance of warrant.

5. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such warrants or orders, and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the moneys are paid shall be a valid discharge to the Treasurer in passing his accounts for any sum therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Indemnity.

6. The issue or application of any part or parts of the said sums of Ninety-five thousand one hundred and twelve pounds fifteen shillings and eleven pence, Thirty-five thousand nine hundred and fifty-six pounds twelve shillings and eleven pence, and Seventeen thousand one hundred and eighty-four pounds ten shillings and twopence, which has been made before the passing of this Act for the purposes expressed in the said Schedules marked I, K, and L, is hereby authorised and sanctioned, and the Treasurer is hereby indemnified against all claims and liabilities in respect of any such issue or application.
