No. 12. THE INCOME TAX Act AMENDMENT ACT OF 1920, No. 2.

11 Geo. V. An Act to Amend in a certain particular "The Income Tax Act of 1902" as amended by subsequent Acts.

[ASSENTED TO 4TH JANUARY, 1921.]

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty. by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :----

1. This Act may be cited as "The Income Tax Act and construction Amendment Act of 1920, No. 2," and shall be read as one with *"The Income Tax Act of 1902" and its several amendments (herein collectively referred to as the Principal Act).
