MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,—

WE, Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, Preamble.
the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in the last and present Sessions of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. In addition to the several sums specified in the Parts marked respectively A, B, C, D, and E of the Schedule to this Act, and which sums are payable under the authority of the several Acts in those Parts respectively mentioned, there shall and may be issued and applied, towards making good the supplies granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending on the last day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-five, the sums following, inclusive of the two sums of Nine million pounds, and Ten million four hundred thousand pounds, already authorised to be applied towards the service of the year ending on the last day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-five, by **"The Appropriation Act of 1943-1944, No. 2,"* and †*"The Appropriation Act of 1944-1945, No. 1,"* respectively, that is to say,—

From the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Queensland (exclusive of the moneys standing to the credit of the Loan Fund Account), the sum of

Nineteen million five hundred and forty thousand four hundred and fifty-nine pounds ;

From the Trust and Special Funds, the sum of Sixteen million two hundred and ninety-three thousand one hundred and forty-eight pounds ;

From the moneys standing to the credit of the Loan Fund Account, the sum of Two million nine hundred and sixty-four thousand two hundred and fifty pounds.

Appropriation.

2. There shall and may be issued and applied, towards making good the supplies granted to His Majesty for the services of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-six, the sums following, that is to say,—

From the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Queensland (exclusive of the moneys standing to the credit of the Loan Fund Account), the sum of Three million five hundred thousand pounds ;

From the Trust and Special Funds, the sum of Four million pounds ;

From the moneys standing to the credit of the Loan Fund Account, the sum of Eight hundred thousand pounds.

Appropriation of sums voted for Supply services. [Schedule, Parts F, G, and H.]

3. The sums granted by the first section of this Act and by **“The Appropriation Act of 1943–1944, No. 2,”* and †*“The Appropriation Act of 1944–1945, No. 1,”* and which are set forth in the Parts marked respectively F, G, and H of the Schedule to this Act, amounting as appears by the said Parts, in all to the sum of Thirty-eight million seven hundred and ninety-seven thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven pounds, are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and forty-four, for the purposes and services expressed in the said Parts F, G, and H respectively.

Supplementary appropriation, 1943–1944.

4. There shall and may be issued and applied the further sums following, that is to say,—

From the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Queensland (exclusive of the moneys standing to the credit of the Loan Fund Account), a further

sum of One million four hundred and seventeen thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven pounds three shillings and six pence ;

From the Trust and Special Funds, a further sum of Two million two hundred and forty-six thousand three hundred and fifty-nine pounds fifteen shillings and seven pence ;

From the moneys standing to the credit of the Loan Fund Account, a further sum of Four hundred and eighty-five thousand seven hundred and fifty-five pounds seven shillings and five pence ;

to defray Supplementary Charges for the service of the year ended on the last day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-four, and such sums shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and forty-three, for the purposes and services expressed in the Parts marked I, J, and K of the Schedule to this Act.

5. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, to such persons, upon such days, and in such proportions as the Governor, by any warrant or order under his hand and directed to the Treasurer, from time to time orders and directs, and the payments so made shall be charged upon and be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Queensland.

Treasurer to pay moneys as directed by warrant.

6. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such warrants or orders, and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the moneys are paid shall be a valid discharge to the Treasurer in passing his accounts for any sum therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Treasurer to be allowed credit for sums paid in pursuance of warrant.

7. The issue or application of any part or parts of the said sums of One million four hundred and seventeen thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven pounds three shillings and six pence, Two million two hundred and forty-six thousand three hundred and fifty-nine pounds fifteen shillings and seven pence, and Four hundred and eighty-five thousand seven hundred and fifty-five pounds seven shillings and five pence, which has been made before the passing of this Act for

the purposes expressed in the Parts marked I, J, and K of the Schedule to this Act, is hereby authorised and sanctioned, and the Treasurer is hereby indemnified against all claims and liabilities in respect of any such issue or application.
